Background:

In South Sudan, GIZ works on behalf of the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development in the following three priority areas: Agriculture and Food Security, Urban water supply and sanitation, Rural development and good governance. GIZ's coordination office has been in the capital, Juba, since 2010.

The GIZ Coordination Office Juba is urgently seeking a qualified candidate to fill the vacant position of Technical Advisor - Natural Resource Management in Aweil for its project "Food Security and Management of Natural Resources".

Scope of the Position:

Generally, the Technical Advisor works independently with guidelines defined by the Head of Component, and in accordance with GIZ processes and rules. The Technical Advisor responds promptly and competently to matters that fall within his/her assigned thematic area, where applicable in consultation with his/her line manager.

- ❖ Support in the overall planning and implementation of the natural resource management activities
- ❖ Support in the preparation of the operational activities, budget and determining of the priority activities
- ❖ Develop joint operational plan for implementing partners in coordination with Head of Component
- ❖ Assist national and international consultants in carrying out their work
- ❖ Support preparation, implementation, and documentation of training events, workshops, forums, team meetings and other project activities
- ❖ Provide advice and facilitate trainings on e.g. natural resource management, water resources management, community-based planning, disaster risk management
- ❖ Represent GIZ in partner coordination forums and meetings in the state
- ❖ Ensure knowledge management; collect, process, and distribute relevant information; monitor communication and interaction between government institutions, NGOs and society through analyses of the media, direct dialogue, participation in meetings and seminars

- ❖ Bachelor's degree in natural resource management, environmental science, or related; MSc degree is an advantage
- ❖ At least 5 years of professional experience in natural resource management, disaster risk management, including integrated planning and implementation
- ❖ Experience in participatory planning and collaborating with community committees as well as local authorities
- ❖ Experience in planning, implementing and monitoring of development projects in South Sudan (experience in working with international organizations is an advantage)
- ❖ Experience in planning and implementation of capacity building measures, such as trainings and workshops
